
<u>Marriage</u>: Engaged couples must meet with the Pastor at least six months prior to the Wedding.

# **PASTOR'S CORNER**

#### Dear Friends,

This Sunday we celebrate the *Second Sunday of Easter* concluding what is called the "Octave" of Easter. Each day this past week has been considered as if it were "Easter Day" itself because liturgically speaking the joy of Easter cannot be contained in just one day. It spills over fully for 8 consecutive days. At the conclusion of Mass this weekend, we will sing the "double Alleluia" as we did last Sunday to highlight this connection, but we will hear it again on Pentecost Sunday when the Easter season formally concludes. The 50 days of the Easter Season are permeated with the joy of the Risen Christ and these great Sundays especially are an opportunity for us to renew our belief in the Resurrection of Christ and of our own resurrection one day by virtue of our baptism by which we have all been given a "new life" as His sons and daughters.

This Sunday has also come to be known in more recent times as *Divine Mercy Sunday*. Rooted in Christ's revelations to St. Maria Faustina Kowalska, St. Pope John Paul II established this feast worldwide according to the motto which is at the heart of the gospel, "Jesus, I Trust in You." It reminds us that our God is a God who is more interested in our future than our past. He is a God who forgives and when we experience his mercy, trust grows in our heart. It is trust which extinguishes the fires of fear. The generosity of God's mercy gives us the confidence to overcome our fear and trust in Him. In this Easter Season, let us call down the full abundance of the Lord's mercy on ourselves, our families, and our community that we might always trust in his care and providence especially during these uncertain and trying times in our world today.

Next weekend on **Sunday, April 14**<sup>th</sup> we will welcome **Bishop Keith Chylinski** to celebrate the **10 AM Mass**. As many of you know, the Archdiocese of Philadelphia recently consecrated 3 new Auxiliary Bishops on March 7<sup>th</sup>. We should be especially proud here at OLA as Bishop Keith is a "son" of our parish. Keith moved to OLA when he was in high school and was an active member singing in our choir for many years and involved in other parish programs. Many of you at that time came to know him and love him. Bishop Keith will then come to celebrate a Mass of Thanksgiving and it will be followed by a light reception. It is my hope to present him with a gift on behalf of our parish community following the Mass. As has been announced, we are collecting donations in order to gift him with a full set of Mass vestments along with a matching bishop's Mitre. Special envelopes are available in the vestibule of the church, and you may simply place your donation in the collection basket or drop it off at the Parish Office. We look forward to his pastoral visit to welcome him home on this historic occasion. We should all be honored that one of our own has been consecrated an Auxiliary Bishop for the Archdiocese of Philadelphia.

Just as a reminder, *Easter Water* is available at the front of the church in the covered silver vessel located near the baptismal font. If you wish, you may bring an empty bottle to church to take some of this blessed Easter Water home during this Season of Easter. Holy Water may be placed in small fonts at the doorway of your homes, or it may simply be kept in a safe place to be used occasionally to bless yourself, your family members or to be sprinkled in the rooms of your homes. Of course, Holy Water can be taken anytime from the church throughout the year, but in this time above all it is even more appropriate as we celebrate our new life in Christ.

I want to thank again all those who made the celebrations of Holy Week and Easter so prayerful and beautiful this year. We thank all of our volunteers who decorated the church, it looks so beautiful. I want to thank our liturgical ministers (our servers, lectors, cantors, ushers, extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion). In a special way, I want to thank our choir under the direction of Anne Sprissler and Maria Dell'Orefice (accompanist) who provided such beautiful music for the Sacred Triduum & the Easter Sunday liturgies. We are so blessed to have such dedicated people involved to make our celebrations so beautiful, inspiring and uplifting.

This past Thursday we celebrated the Sacrament of Penance with our candidates who are preparing to receive their First Holy Communion. There are 24 boys and girls this year. Please pray for them as they continue their journey to receive Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament on April 27<sup>th</sup>.

Once again, I thank you for your generosity to OLA this Easter and I hope and pray that you and your families will continue to be blessed by the joy and peace of the Risen Christ.
