Deacon John and Bette Jo's presence will be greatly missed!

Twenty-two years ago, we celebrated Deacon John's ordination and assignment to Our Lady of the Assumption Church: a church he grew up in, where he made his sacraments, and served as an altar boy. OLA is the place where John began his journey of diaconal service, and a place that he and his supportive wife and partner in his ministry "will carry in their hearts wherever they go".

John spent these past twenty-two years assisting the priests where needed and as needed. RCIA means Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults.

To others it means Real Christian Investigating and Affirming!

Mission: RCIA is a process of initiation in the sacramental life of the Catholic Church. Our primary concern is with living the fundamental values of the Christian way of life. The process is focused on conversion, both for those entering the Catholic Church, and for those who try to live the values of Christ each day. Our goal is for an experience of growth in faith for those who wish to enter the Catholic Church, as well as all who join us.

RCIA is designed for adults who, after hearing the mystery of Christ proclaimed, consciously and freely seek the living God and enter the way of faith and conversion as the Holy Spirit opens their hearts. The rite includes not simply the celebration of the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist but also all the rites belonging to the catechumenate (e.g. rite of Election, the Scrutinies, etc.) The rite is designed for the preparation of a group of candidates but may be adapted by pastors to be suitable for one person. The rites also include guidelines for preparing uncatechized adults for Confirmation and Eucharist and the rite of reception of baptized Christians into the full communion of the Catholic Church.

CASSEROLES FOR THE HOMELESS

Mission: "To provide meals for those in need in the wider community."

Casseroles for the Homeless is an opportunity for the OLA Parish community to prepare a full meal for eight people. The meal should include protein, vegetables, and a starch, with heating instructions, and should be frozen. The pans are provided in the Giving Room on top of the freezer where the casseroles are placed when prepared. If you need a recipe idea, there are several in an envelope on the freezer. If you are looking for a way to participate on your own schedule, consider making a casserole.

As the freezer fills up, the casseroles are distributed to parishioners and local families in need, at My Brother's House in Philadelphia, and the Patrician Society in Norristown. If you would like to assist with the delivery, we always welcome assistance with this task. Please call us to discuss.

Each year, the number of casseroles prepared grows. Thank you for your generous support.
